Know the Food Network, know Lynn Crawford, the ebullient star of Pitchin' In, who splashes through Canada, dancing with piglets. As well, an Iron Chef contender and host of Restaurant Makeover. Know, too, that she threw over the Four Seasons Hotel in New York, where she was the luxury chain's only female exec chef, to open her own place in Riverside.

Riverside! Cruise this shabby/genteel strip of Queen, east of Don Valley, past the New Broadview Hotel and Jillie's, the girlie show, and there it is, Ruby Watchco, a storefront with a big red R.

Crawford and her co-owners, designer Cherie Stinson and her husband, Joey Skeir, have transformed the old Citizen resto into comfort funk, a sinuous space ornamented with found objects retrieved from the area's industrial past. Up front is a casual café morphing into a formal line of banquettes opposite the long bar, then opening into a glowing dining room lit by the open kitchen and chef Crawford's command post.
